

BIOGRAPHY

Born Enrico Nicola Mancini in Cleveland and raised in Pittsburgh, Henry Mancini is one of the biggest names in the contemporary genre. He changed the world of motion picture and television music. Mancini recorded over 90 albums in his career, contributed to 100 movies and 600 symphony performances. Mancini was an American composer, conductor, arranger, pianist, and flutist who went from arranging the Glenn Miller Orchestra to writing music for some of the most known theme songs in television and film.

- The music from *Peter Gunn* won Mancini the inaugural Grammy Award for Album of the Year
- The Henry Mancini Institute, an academy for young music professionals, was founded in 1996 by Jack Elliot
- The American Film Institute ranked "Moon River" No.4 and "Days of Wine and Roses" No. 39 on their list of Greatest Songs and The Pink Panther No.20 on their list of Greatest Film Score
- Honored with a commemorative postage stamp (2004)
