Contours imply a practice of mapping, documenting place and re-contextualising shared histories. Ripples and nautical suggestions locate the visual identity in Deptford, avoiding explicit shipyard symbolism.












A MALEABLE PALETTE

This visual strategy is designed with the intent to accomodate a broad colour range, as to match the diverse imagery and bodies occupying the TRACED project. Colour pallettes are drawn directly from the content, rather than strictly predetermined. In line with this, selected colours should generally be muted, and complimentary with skin tones, as to not detract from content imagery.






